The following endorsements may only be added through a complete college program (Pathway 3): Designated Arts: Dance, Music – Choral, General, Instrumental, Theater Arts, Visual Arts; Designated CTE: Agriculture Education, Business and Marketing Education, Family and Consumer Sciences Education, Technology Education; Bilingual Education; Health/Fitness; Special Education; and Traffic Safety Education.

The following pre-2007 endorsements are not eligible for Pathway 1 or 2: 4-12 Anthropology, 4-12 Computer Science, 4-12 Comparative Religion, English – Primary, English – Supporting, 4-12 English, 4-12 Economics, 4-12 Geography, 4-12 Health, 4-12 Instructional Technology, 4-12 Journalism, Middle Level – Primary, 4-12 Philosophy, 4-12 Political Science, 4-12 Psychology, 4-12 Sociology, 4-12 Speech.
